Surrealism:

Inspired by the work of Maggie Taylor

OBJECTIVE:

This assignment is meant to get you sketching and designing an interesting graphic in Photoshop. The final piece will be surreal. Use symbolism and think about meaning and concept. You can also use metaphors, puns, literature, movies, or art to inspire your dream like piece.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Choose 5 works form the artists above as inspiration
- 2) Create 5 sketches for your piece, plan out the collage
- 3) Begin downloading vintage images and putting together the PS composite.

DEADLINES:

Week 5: Begin searching for inspiration, creating sketches, and downloading components.

Week 6: Share research with professor; begin creating final image in Photoshop.

Week 7: Work on Project

Week 8: Project DUE

FINAL REQUIREMENTS: This assignment is about using Photoshop as a tool to transform and create! It is also about learning to take an idea from sketch to completion.

- FILE: Layered, 300 ppi, PSD file and a web ready jpeg file, 72 ppi.
- **COMPONENTS:** You may not DISTORT the object, SCALE while holding shift. Vintage photographs and illustrations can be used, along with your own material.
- **IMAGES:** All work from other's must be licensed, document the websites you find images from.

- **IMAGE LAYERS:** 10 layers minimum, images, non-destructive editing, color, etc.
- ADJUSTMENT LAYERS: At least 2, used for tone and color correction.
- **BLENDING MODES:** Use at least2 to create dramatic effects to the image.
- SIZE: 300 ppi .PSD format, either 8 x10 or 8x8
- **FINAL IMAGE**: It must resemble your original planning in some way to show research and planning.

Hand Coloring Layer/s
Clone/Heal Layer
Layers named for what they are
Layer Groups named for organization
Proper layer hierarchy
Linking of layers
Layer masks
Proper selection methods to make clean edges
